Romans 10:11-15 KJVS

For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. [12] For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him. [13] For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. [14] How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher? [15] And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

The Romans Road to Salvation

Romans Road lays out the plan of salvation through a series of Bible verses from the book of Romans. When arranged in order, these verses form an easy, systematic way of explaining the message of salvation.

- Who needs salvation.***
- Why we need salvation.***
- How God provides salvation.***
- How we receive salvation.***
- The results of salvation.***

1. Everyone needs salvation because all have sinned.

Romans 3:10-12, and 23

As the Scriptures say, "No one is righteous—not even one. No one is truly wise; no one is seeking God. All have turned away; all have become useless. No one does good, not a single one." ... For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. (NLT)

Romans 5:8

But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners. (NLT)

Romans 6:23

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord. (NLT)

2. The price (or consequence) of sin is death, but:

- ***Jesus Christ died for our sins. He paid the price for our death, because of the love of God for humanity.
(John 3:16-17 NLT - For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. God sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world through him.)***
- ***So we receive salvation and eternal life through faith in Jesus Christ.(Ephesians 2:8-9 NKJV - For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.)***

Romans 10:9-10, and 13

If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved ... For “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” (NLT)

3. Salvation through Jesus Christ brings us into a relationship of peace with God.

Romans 5:1

Therefore, since we have been made right in God’s sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us. (NLT)

Romans 8:1

So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. (NLT)

Romans 8:38-39

And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord. (NLT)

4. Responding to Romans Road

If you believe Romans Road leads to the path of truth, you can respond by receiving God's free gift of salvation today.

Here's how to take a personal journey down Romans Road:

- Admit you are a sinner.***
- Understand that as a sinner, you deserve death.***
- Believe Jesus Christ died on the cross to save you from sin and death.***
- Repent by turning from your old life of sin to a new life in Christ.***
- Receive, through faith in Jesus Christ, his free gift of salvation.***

Pray this Prayer now:

“Father, your word says If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. O God, I believe in my heart that Jesus died for my sins and was raised on the 3rd day for my justification and now He is seated at your right hand. I confess Him today as the Lord of my life, therefore in line with your word accept me as your child today. I am born again through faith in what Jesus has done for me. Thank you Lord today for my salvation . Praise God.

If you decided to repent of your sins and receive Christ today, welcome to God's family. Now, as a way to grow closer to Him, the Bible tells us to follow up on our commitment.

- ***Get baptized as commanded by Christ.***
- ***Tell someone else about your new faith in Christ***
- ***Spend time with God each day. It does not have to be a long period of time.***
- ***Just develop the daily habit of praying to Him and reading His Word.***
- ***Ask God to increase your love for Him and your understanding of the Bible.***
- ***Seek fellowship with other followers of Jesus.***
- ***Develop a group of believing friends to answer your questions and support you.***
- ***Find a local church where you can worship God.***
